- Deepen our team expertise in pro-pathways, including finding credible certificate and trade programs, service years, and gap year options
- Collaborate with Director of Postsecondary Pathways to launch near-peer advisement model for alumni, and support with training, support and supervision
- Coordinate efforts, in collaboration with the Alumni Advisory Board and Research and Evaluation partner, to identify key metrics for alumni thriving, aligned with measuring alumni persistence and completion outcomes, through Enroll database
- Support with planning and staffing alumni events
- Participate in CACNY, NYSACAC, CUNY/Graduate NYC Network for College Success (N4CS) and other key coalitions and networks related to our work and this role
